- What is your level of certification? A CLC (Certified Lactation Counselor) has 45 hours of Lactation training and can assist with many General Lactation issues, and refer if needed. An IBCLC (International Board Certified Lactation Consultant) has 90 hours of Lactation training, plus 1000 hours of clinical, and may be able to assist with more complicated lactation issues.
- Do you charge an extra fee to come to my home?
- Do you bring an accurate baby scale to the visit, if needed?
